Bring plants from your garden. Have them in a nursery pots or sturdy plastic bags. Bring them to the Jackley Park pavilion between

9:15 – 10:00 a.m., Saturday, MAY 18th.

- Label them by name, sun/partial/shade, flower color, blooming time, care, height, etc.
- "Bring One, Take One" You will receive one or more coupons for each plant you bring depending on size and rarity. You can use these coupons to "purchase" other plants. No need to spend money.
- You may also purchase plants for \$1 to \$4 if you don't have plants to share. Money will be put into the Creekside Neighborhood treasury to help fund projects this year.
- Examples of plants to bring: hosta, day lilies, ferns, bulbs, peonies, lily of the valley, bleeding hearts, cannas, other annual & perennial plants, and tree volunteers (no buckthorn).
